

Have you ever settled down to track down findings to do with **Expert Tax Barristers** just to find yourself staring dumbfounded at your computer screen? I know I have.

Tax barristers are experienced in drafting notices of appeal and formulating grounds of appeal as well as advising on the suitability of making an appeal. There are new powers bestowed on HMRC to demand tax up front, before an appeal, in certain avoidance cases; and even – essentially – without an appeal in other avoidance cases. This has brought tax law and public law close together. Tax barristers support clients in both an advisory and litigation capacity. Remuneration in the workplace is rarely straightforward and yet is high on the list of priorities of all concerned. A well-designed remuneration package is not just tax-efficient; it can motivate staff to achieve levels of performance that go far beyond the norm. Some specialist barristers act as lead counsel in commercial litigation and arbitration, especially where accounting, valuation and capital markets requirements are in issue. A tax barristers indirect customers may include pension scheme trustees, employers, individual members, insurers, scheme administrators and advisers and regulatory bodies including the Pensions Regulator, the Financial Conduct Authority and the Pension Protection Fund.



Some tax barristers are former solicitors valued for their strong advice to taxpayers on employment and corporate tax related issues. Occasionally HMRC may threaten bankruptcy or liquidation if tax is not paid, even if the matter is under appeal to the Tribunal. The Courts have held that a bankruptcy petition by HMRC in these circumstances will not succeed if the taxpayer can show a bone fide dispute on substantial grounds. Excepted group life trusts /

policies and guaranteed minimum pensions (GMP) issues may require assistance from a pension barrister. Tax barristers can take on cases exclusively concerned with taxation in jurisdictions outside the UK, such as Hong Kong, Ireland or the UK's overseas territories. Specialist assistance for [Inheritance Tax Advice](#) should be sought whenever required.

Full Of Ideas And Helpful Suggestions

The best European tax advocates have an extensive knowledge of European case law and invariably get to the heart of any dispute quickly. Amendments to rules and governing documentation is a matter that a pension barrister will have experience in. Barristers, solicitors or lawyers can provide advice to pension scheme trustees generally and advises in relation to litigious and overseas pension issues such as QROPS. Reflect the idea that tax is raised to allow spending, and not, as is actually the case, that tax is the reclamation of spending that has already happened. Tax affects all of us and knowing what to pay and when is not always straightforward. Penalties for fraudulent or corrupt behaviour are varied and depend on the situation, but can result in either major fines being issued or imprisonment where individuals are concerned. An experienced barrister is essential for investigations in this area. A specialist tax consultancy may work with individuals, businesses and other professional advisers. Expert pensions barristers can advise on unaffordable pension debt insolvency-related restructurings and apportionments. Tax and pension specialists may have experience documenting complex investment solutions, including asset backed funding arrangements and derivative investments through ISDAs. Take Advice Personally

Barristers are required to carry indemnity insurance to cover the legal services they provide. Appealing penalties and surcharges for individual tax affairs are an area of HMRC tax investigations that tax barristers can assist with. Pensions barristers advise on the legal aspects of long-term pension scheme funding arrangements with a view to the scheme's overall journey plan towards self-sufficiency and/or buyout. There is no simple definition of the English legal term "domicile". It is a concept which is distinct from residence, nationality and citizenship. In very simple terms, a person is domiciled in the territory with which the law regards him as having his most permanent connection. Seek legal advice if you are unsure.
